SIGN UP

Each potential athlete is encouraged to check the Athletics Board on a daily basis to find out when team try-outs and sign ups are coming. Often sports are oversubscribed, so you are encouraged to complete your applications and submit your applicable fees as soon as possible, prior to the start of the sport season.

PROGRAM FEES

As these are extracurricular programs, there are additional costs that the CCS Society Program fees do not cover. These additional fees go to cover the costs of referees, banners, medals and tournaments. We require each player to provide 2 cheques payable to CCS. The first cheque is to cover a jersey deposit. The second cheque is to cover league fees.

PRACTICES AND TOURNAMENTS

The following schedule deals with prescheduled practice days. Please work with the coaches and the locations of the practices at either our Secondary campus, or our Elementary campus. Specific times will be shared once teams are formed and a full schedule will be circulated as well as shared on the CCS Website Athletics section link to our facilities calendar. Tournaments often occur on weekends, so please keep in touch with your coach and check the website often for updates.

More specifically, basketball and volleyball cover the following game times and tournament expectations. Practices often occur in the mornings at either campus from 7:00 to 8:00 AM.

At that time, roles of coaches, parents and students will be covered as they pertain to the specific league play.
