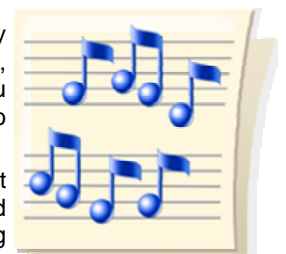
SECONDARY

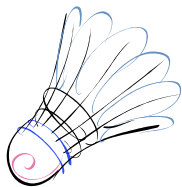

~ **BADMINTON 2010 – CCS WINS THE CISAA CHAMPIONSHIP!** This year will certainly be one to remember for the High School Badminton Team! After “too many years” of finishing second by one or two points they finally were able to accomplish what no one “before the time of banners” was able to do. They won the team banner and are the reigning CISAA Sr. High Champions for 2010! With 32 athletes competing in this years CISAA Badminton tournament on April 20-23 every point was needed to edge out West Island College by one point! Congratulations to all team members for making badminton history here at CCHS, and to our coaches Greg Smith and Simon Strydhorst for their leadership and expertise!

~ **Track and Field:** Despite the difficult weather conditions of late April and early May, the track team persisted and is now in the middle of a very competitive, albeit, short season. The CISAA HS Track Meet was held at the Glenmore Track on May 12, and although our athletes were fewer in number than last year, the Cougars represented CCS very well! Many of our 25 athletes finished in the top 6 taking third overall among the other 17 High Schools at this years' meet with 8 athletes qualifying for the Calgary Zone Challenge Track Meet at the Foothills Track on May 29. Bryce Clements had an especially strong meet finishing first in the 100m sprint, first in the 100m hurdles and first as the anchor of the Junior Boys 4x100m Relay team (including Nathan Ostenbrink, Tinyan Leung and Gerrit VanHolst) setting a new 4x100m Relay Meet Record with a time of 47.23 seconds! 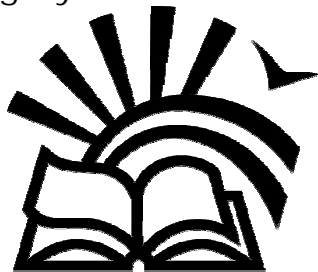
