AT LAKE LOUISE ON MARCH 18, 2019

Monday, March 18, 2019 is Outdoor Adventure Day at CCS. Your child has chosen to participate in downhill skiing or snowboarding at Lake Louise.

In order to follow due process, all students will be required to participate in a mandatory one hour lesson at the start of the day regardless of skiing/boarding experience. There is also an option for a full-day lesson for those who are new to the sport of downhill skiing/snowboarding. Once lessons are complete, students meet in the lodge and divide into groups, it is mandatory to ski in groups of at least 3 people. If you are a beginner skier/boarder, it is highly recommended that you take a full day lesson. Pricing for these options is listed on the attached forms.

Buses will leave the CCS parking lot at 6:00 AM. Our anticipated return time is around 6:30/7:00 PM. If you choose to drive your child instead of having them take the bus, please indicate on the attached form. We have transportation for 108 people so the first 108 to return their forms and fees will be joining us on the buses. If there is room available, parents who are coming will be notified and can purchase a ride on the bus for a fee.

Parents are encouraged to join us for the day. Discounted lift tickets are available for \$90. Please indicate if you would like to join us and if you are in need of a lift ticket, rentals and/or a bus ride. Parents will need to fill out the "Individual Information Form" to receive the lift ticket and/or rentals.

It is crucial that your child be dressed for the weather so please ensure they have a warm jacket, snow pants, and gloves/mittens. Helmets are required and are included with all rental packages.

The attached forms need to be filled out completely and **submitted to the front office, with payment, no later than Friday, February 1**, as we need to submit our information to Lake Louise.

Level 4	You can comfortably link turns on green runs and occasionally ski easy blue runs. Your skis are mostly parallel.
Level 5	You ski blue runs with confidence and enjoy the challenge of black runs and varied terrain, but you have difficulty skiing them with style.

Snowboard Ability Levels

Level 1	This is your first time snowboarding.
Level 2	You ride cautiously and find green runs a challenge.
Level 3	You ride the chairlift and ride green runs comfortably but would like more confidence.
Level 4	Snowboard blue runs. Want to learn to jump & basic tricks.
