We can never go wrong with Taco Pie followed by Jesus' Birthday Cake for dessert! Close runners up are Chicken Goop (basically a chicken pot pie served over biscuits) and a Cheese and Bacon Quiche. The recipe for Taco Pie is basic and easy: Line a 9x13 inch pan with crescent rolls (flattened) and bake until the crescent rolls are golden brown. Meanwhile, brown some ground beef and season with taco seasoning. Add in black beans, corn, anything else that sounds good. Layer the 9x13 pan with refried beans, the meat and beans mixture, salsa, sour cream, and top with shredded cheese. Pop it back in the oven to melt the cheese, and then serve when ready! # CHEESECAKE FOR JESUS' BIRTHDAY CAKE

2 (8 OZ.) PKG. CREAM CHEESE 1 (14 OZ.) CAN SWEETENED CONDENSED MILK 3 EGGS

1 T. VANILLA EXTRACT

1 T. ALMOND EXTRACT (TO GET AMARETTO TASTE OTHERWISE INCREASE VANILLA TO 2 T.)
OR

3 T. FLOUR

3 T. AMARETTO LIQUOR

IN MIXING BOWL BEAT CREAM CHEESE UNTIL FLUFFY. GRADUALLY BEAT IN SWEETENED CONDENSED MILK, UNTIL SMOOTH. ADD EGGS AND VANILLA. MIX WELL.

YIELD: 1-9" LAYER FOR CAKE. BE SURE AND LINE CAKE PAN WITH ALUMINUM FOIL. BAKE AT 350 UNTIL CENTER IS SET, APPROX. 15 MIN

ALSO WILL YIELD ADDITIONAL 18 CUPCAKES. BE SURE AND USE PAPER LINERS FOR CUPCAKES AND EITHER SPRINKLE SOME GRAHAM CRACKER CRUMBS IN BOTTOM FOR CRUST OR USE 1 VANILLA WAFER ON BOTTOM FOR CRUST. FREEZE AFTER BAKING TO ENJOY LATER AS MINI CHEESECAKES. BAKE AT 350 UNTIL SET; APPROX. 15 MIN
