MAKE A BOX OF SUNSHINE

Make someone feel special by making them a box of sunshine! This is a super easy and fun project, and is a really kind thing to do. What you will be doing in this activity is making a box of sunshine for a friend, family member, relative, ect. You can theme it after a color too. We suggest making everything yellow because it is a box of sunshine.

What you will need for this project:

- A nice box (A decorative shoe box will work great)
- A card
- Lots of little things your person will love!

Step 1: Pick a person you want to give your box to. This can be a friend, family member, relative, teacher, ect.

Step 2: Find a decorative box. You can pick one up at any arts and crafts store. If you don't have a box or can't get one, you can take a normal shoe box or box and cover it in decorative tape, decorative paper, or you can cover it in paper and draw on it.

Step 3: Think about what your person would like. What are they interested in? What do they like? What colors do they like? What do they need?

Step 4: When you have decided on what they might like, go to the store and pick it up. Be sure to pick a bunch of little things rather than one big thing. If you can't think of anything here are some suggestions: Pretty masks, cake mix, bath bombs, chips, gum, candles, candy, lotion, art supplies, lip balm, nail polish, tissues, balloons, soap, socks, chocolate covered fruits, chocolate bars, cookies, stickers, flowers, fake flowers, a clothing article. Make sure the things you buy are inexpensive.

Step 5: We suggest putting at least one piece of your own artwork in your box. It can be anything you make. A painting, a drawing, a crochet item, a knit item, a sewed item. Anything that you made. It makes the box that much sweeter!

Step 6: Gather all the objects you bought or made, organise them in them in the box in a nice way. Be sure that it's not messy, it shows that you took time and cared. Also make sure to remove any price tags on your items.

Step 7: Make a card with some construction paper and markers. You can use any art supplies you have to make it with. If you bought a card, fill it out. Be sure to make it short and sweet. Put in a nice message and sign your name. If you don't want your person to know who it's from, don't sign your name. Step 8: Put your card in the box and add some tissue paper on top. Seal the box and go deliver it. You can give it to the person directly, set it on their doorstep, or put it somewhere you're sure they will find it. You're all done! Great job! 
