And I know and feel that you are real.

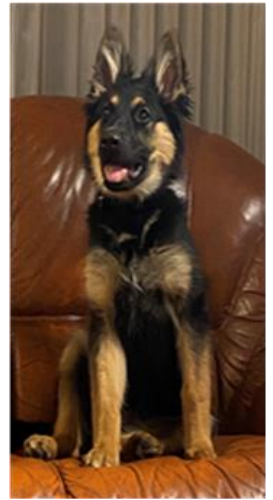
I instantly fell in love with you.
