- IT: Our school is a partnership between Palliser and Calgary Society. One example of this partnership benefiting the school includes an occurrence when fibre connection had been put into our school yet was not properly activated until a Palliser technician came to investigate the connection and noticed it was not being utilized. As the current connectivity was not optimal for the Elementary school, Palliser was able to negotiate a significantly lower rate while increasing connection points with greater access to internet for all.
- Assurance Reporting: As part of Palliser School Division, we need to create school goals. The example is the 4-year education plan which is organized around the five

primary domains within education (student growth and achievement, Teaching and Leading, Learning Supports, Governance, Attending to Local and Societal Context) as well as the Fourteen elements to provide assurance. This will be shared in full through the weekly bulletin email.
