

CSCE Board Purpose



"to undertake and promote scripturally directed learning of children – so that the Word of God in all its power is brought to bear upon the whole of their lives – and to this end, to establish, control and develop Christian elementary schools and Christian secondary schools for their daily instruction and education"

- Integration of Christian worldview in all curricular & extra-curricular activities at CCS
- Principals, teachers, staff & volunteers will refrain from promoting their personal theological beliefs except to the extent as specifically addressed in the Foundational Documents
- Foundational Documents:
 - CSCE Objects
 - Basis & Educational Creed
 - CCS Educational Vision & Philosophy

• Guiding Principles

- Christian doctrine, theology and practice taught in a positive and apologetic manner
- Historic doctrine, theology and practice of the Reformed tradition may be the starting point for teaching or discussing Christian doctrine, theology and practice
- CCS is established for the promotion and advancement of Christian education consistent with the Foundational Documents

- **CSCE is not a church** and does not promote the doctrine, theology or practice of any particular Christian denomination
- Integrating a Christian worldview in all subjects consistent with Foundational Documents
- Review and consistently affirm the primary role of Scripture in analyzing issues including comprehensive reading and mediation on Scripture

- Teaching of Christian doctrine, theology and practice at CCS is a partnership involving school and parents, where:
 - School teaches Christian doctrine, theology and encourages Christian beliefs and practices to develop the Christian faith in students; not to promote any particular set of Christian beliefs except those in the Foundational Documents
 - Parents promote and encourage Christian beliefs and practices in their children and development of Christian faith consistent with Foundational Documents and your church community

- Topics involving matters known to be the subject of controversy or division:
 - Confined to classes set for such topics
 - Students encouraged to speak to their parents about their beliefs and practices and that of their church community
 - Parents may request and school to facilitate removal of student from any lesson which is objectionable to parents

- Guiding Principles con't.
 - Discussions on Christian doctrine, theology or practice:
 - Open, honest, gentle and respectful discussion and debate among students is welcomed and encouraged
 - Words and actions to be in a spirit of love
 - Intent to educate and inform
 - Encourage all participants to engage
 - Apply the truth of God's Word

- Christian doctrine, theology or practice **will not be used to**:
 - Belittle, insult or bully others
 - Engagement in such actions will be **subject to appropriate sanction**

- This policy applies to:
 - Board of Directors
 - All members of CSCE
 - Principals & teaching staff
 - All CSCE staff
 - All volunteers
 - All students

Constructively Addressing Concerns...

- Get the facts and seek to understand the context
- First approach those directly involved in a spirit of humility and love
- Ask questions, listen and **seek to understand**
- If resolution is not achieved, elevate to next level
 Teacher Principal Executive Director Board
 - CSCE Staff \implies Executive Director \implies Board
- **Resist gossip**, rumours and heresy
- Focus on being united and being part of our CCS community
- We are **role models** for our children and CCS students

- Clearly state your name & child's grade
- If your concern or question has already been raised, please allow others the opportunity to speak
