#### **Assurance Framework**

The Assurance Framework is a new system Alberta Education uses to ensure all schools are providing the best possible education. It focuses on five key areas:

- Student Growth and Achievement, ensuring students are continuously learning and succeeding;
- 2. Teaching and Leading, emphasizing quality teaching and leadership;
- 3. Learning Supports, creating supportive and inclusive environments;
- 4. Governance, ensuring effective management and decision-making; and
- 5. Local and Societal Context, adapting to the unique needs of our community.

This approach provides focus as we track our school's progress, improve education quality, and maintain transparency and accountability.

Within each of these key areas, the Palliser school division has outlined what success would look like through the <u>desired states</u>. In partnership with the Calgary Society for Christian Education, we work together as we pursue the desired states here at Calgary Christian Secondary School alongside an experience integrated with our Christian faith.

# Data

## Our Assurance Measure Results

Within the 282 pages found in the link above, the following key takeaways emerge:

| Student Learning Engagement: The school has maintained a strong level of student engagement, with a slight decrease from the previous year but consistent with the previous three-year average. | Citizenship: The school scored very high in citizenship, showing a slight increase from the previous year and exceeding the three-year average. | High School Completion Rates: Both the 3-year and 5-year high school completion rates are very high, with current results outperforming the three-year average.  | Provincial Achievement Tests (PAT) & Diploma Exam Results: The school has very high ratings in both acceptable and excellence categories, indicating strong academic performance.                    | Education Quality: Education quality has been rated as high, with a slight decline from the previous year but still consistent with the three-year average.                                      |

If we compare our school to provincial averages, the following insights were noted:

| Higher Achievement in Many Areas: CCS has outperformed the Alberta average in many measures, notably in the Rutherford Scholarship Eligibility Rate and Safe and Caring environment. This suggests a highly effective educational environment at CCS that supports academic excellence and a positive school culture. | Excellence in Completion and Transition Rates: CCS's completion and transition rates are significantly higher than the provincial averages, indicating that CCS students are completing high school and transitioning to further education or work at a higher rate than the Alberta average. | Consistent Improvement and High Standards: Across most measures, CCS either maintained or improved its performance, often at a level marked as "Very High" or "Excellent." This consistency indicates a robust approach to education that prioritizes continuous improvement and high standards. | Engagement in Lifelong Learning: CCS's measures for lifelong learning are higher than the provincial average, suggesting that the school is successful in instilling a value for continuous learning in its students. |
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| Effective Support for At-Risk Students: The Program of Studies for at-risk students at CCS is high and maintained, which could reflect the effectiveness of the school's interventions and support systems for students who may face academic challenges.   | Lower Satisfaction with Program Access: While still within an acceptable range, CCS has a lower satisfaction rate with program access compared to its other measures. Although it is above the Alberta average, this could be an area for CCS to explore further improvements.                | Strong Community Engagement: The increased parental involvement at CCS, compared to the Alberta average, underscores the active role the community plays in the school's operations and governance, which may contribute to the overall success of the school.                                   |   |

Overall, CCS is performing well, often exceeding provincial averages. The results suggest that CCS is providing a high-quality educational experience, with particular strengths in fostering academic success, creating a safe and caring environment, and engaging the community. However, there are areas where our school can still seek to improve, such as program access - a measure of satisfaction with the accessibility, effectiveness and efficiency of programs and services for students in their community.

The CCS <u>Brand Story</u>, <u>Educational Vision and Philosophy</u>, and our <u>CCS Values</u> present a framework for holistic Christian education focusing on academic, emotional, physical, social, and spiritual development. Together they emphasize integration of faith into all aspects of education, aiming to develop students who will actively serve and positively impact the world.

Though the Alberta Education Assurance Measures serve as a baseline for certain aspects of academic and performance, these standard metrics do not fully capture the distinctly Christian vision CCS holds as a measure for success. As we prepare to share our artifacts of learning, we do so hoping to highlight our broader vision that extends beyond academic achievement alone.
