- **Grade 7/8** students will have their annual trip to Calaway Park on June 19.
- **Grade 7/8** students will be running class as normal through to the end of the day on June 24.
- No scheduled class for **grade 7/8** students on June 25. If a student still has outstanding assignments to complete, they may do so in school on this day.
- **Grade 9** students taking English this semester will have their Part A PAT on June 2.
- **Grade 9-12** semester two classes will end on June 13.
- **Grade 9-12** students can come into the school to study throughout the exam period by appointment with their teacher.
- Credit Recovery days are an opportunity for students or teachers to request additional time to focus on course completion/improvement.
- Note the non-instructional day on June 26 (no students).

- Students writing exams are expected to be in the gym or designated room by 8:45am.
- High school students must bring their student identification or some other form of valid photo identification with them to diploma examinations.
- Students must remain in the exam location for one hour after the final exam has started. Students may not enter the exam location after an hour has passed. Also, students may not return to the exam location after they have left.
- **No** electronic devices of any kind are allowed in the exam location. Any student found to have an electronic device on them will have their exam taken away and will receive a **zero** on that exam.
- Students must write the exam at the time indicated unless special permission has been granted by the teacher.
- Outstanding textbooks should be returned on the day of the exam.
