The Alberta government is currently reviewing and considering new standards for school library collections, specifically regarding materials that may not be appropriate for all children. As a valued partner in your child's education, your input is crucial to this process. The Minister of Education and Childcare is inviting all Albertans, including parents, to share their perspectives on what is deemed acceptable for school library collections through an online survey. This survey is open until June 6, 2025, and your responses will directly inform the development of new government standards that will ensure consistency across all school authorities in Alberta.
